The only thing used was from the section "Why a Century to Publish Marx". That however also was not in toto; skipped was first para. "Because Marx's discovery..." (1st 2 paras. of col. 1). All this is circled p. 4. *157 718*

P. 5 not used. *Aid* (BE SURE TO ATTACK RYAZANOV, VESTNIK, #6, 11/20/23); also in archives of Marx Vol. 9, 1941.

P. 6 (Take out from col. 1, para. 4, vs. HD's "should be considered the joint work of both men.") 1st para. of HD on "primit<sup>i</sup>ve division of labor and Fourier; 4th para 1868 Am. Congress and letter to Kugelman 12/12/1868.

Skip final par. col. 2, HD except "family has to be destroyed";

Use col. 3, final para. on family containing in embryo all antagonisms.

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P. 7 para. 2, from "within primitive communism" ANTAGONISTIC RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN CHIEF AND MASSES. Quote para. 3 vs. FE's glorification of Morgan.

para. 6 on Plutarch and long before dissolution of primitive communism, question of ranks emerges. USE but make footnote of "infinite casuistry" in using of male names

p. 7, col. 1, final para. 8 -- history and its process

p. 8 FE and KM contrasted; para. 2 1850s Taiping Rebellion; para. 4 autonomous groups of WL, para. 5 Eleanor Marx on gas workers and on woman question. Col. 3, the genuine and "Great Divide" is not between sexes but between mental and manual labor

Col. 1, ~~REMOVED~~ para. 3 & 4, (use) especially last para.
