Asad and Syria interest me very much. Could I see any outline of it? Ever since WW II when no revolution comparable to 1917 with Russia itself becoming nothing more state-capitalist, I began extending studies and analysis of dialectics of revolution in new type of nationalisms Est, Middle East, Africa, Latin America and the # 3rd World.
