## Negro Toilers Judge Leaders and Friends By Their Actions

By what test are the Negro workers to recognize their friends? What is the iron test by which we can distinguish friends from enemies? How are the sincerity of our so-called friends and of those who call themselves our leaders to be tested. or an kinds, bites will eventually lead to severe infection. In case of bites from dogs, a serious disease may be contracted called "Rabies." The disease is found in dogs that behave suspiciously. and is spread through the saliva.

When a bite occurs, allow wound to blead freely by use of pressure or by opening the wound with a clean knife. In case of a snake bite, the limb should be tightly bandaged between the wound and the heart in order to prevent the circulation of the poison to the heart. This being done, wash the wound thoroughly under running water in order to wash away the poison, then dry wound and apply tincture of iodine. For bites of insects, make a paste of baking soda with water and apply to parts. A compress of ammonia water is also use-
