Messages of Greetings From Central Committee of Revolutionary Communist Party of Chile

To Chairman Mao

The Central Committee of the Revolutionary Communist Party of Chile sent a message to Chairman Mao Tsetung on September 5, warmly congratulating him on his re-election as Chairman of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China.

The message says: "In the name of our Party and of all the patriotic, democratic and revolutionary sectors

of Chile, we express our warmest congratulations on your re-election as Chairman of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China."

"This fact is a proper expression of the support and recognition given by the people and the Communist Party of China to you who, for more than 50 years, has been leading them from victory to victory," it adds.

The message says that in our era, Comrade Mao Tsetung "is dear to all the humble people, the oppressed and the exploited, is dear to all those who are hankering for independence to their countries and a life of dignity to their people," and "is hated by the imperialists, reactionaries and revisionists, as well as by the exploiters and oppressors of the peoples."

The message says, "Proceeding from the principle of wholeheartedly serving our people and all other peoples of the world, our Party is making its greatest effort to integrate the universal truth of Marxism-Leninism with our concrete practice" so as to "make our modest contribution to the struggle of the peoples of the world against U.S. imperialism, the reactionaries and revisionism headed by the leadership of the C.P.S.U."

The message concludes: "Comrade Mao Tsetung, please accept the expression of our revolutionary affection and respect for you."

To Central Committee of C.P.C.

The Central Committee of the Revolutionary Communist Party of Chile sent a message to the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China on September 5, expressing warm congratulations on the convocation of the Tenth National Congress of the Communist Party of China.

The message says: "The convocation of the Tenth National Congress marks a new stage of great importance in the struggle between the two lines within the Communist Party of China. This signifies a new advance in which the liquidation of the revisionist line of Liu Shao-chi is now followed by the crushing of the Lin Piao anti-Party clique."

It states: "The rich revolutionary history and the correct line of the Communist Party of China headed by Chairman Mao provide valuable lessons to all the revolutionaries of the world." In the class struggle at home and on the international arena, in the criticism of revisionism and of the bourgeois world outlook, in the study of Marxism-Leninism and its integration with the revolutionary practice, in the correct line of building socialism and of continuing the revolution under the dictatorship of the proletariat and continuously strengthening this dictatorship, as well as in many other questions, the experience of the Communist Party of China "has turned China and the Party into a vanguard in the revolutionary, democratic and anti-imperialist struggle of the world."

The message says: "Your Tenth National Congress not only signifies the enormous strengthening of socialism in China, but is sure to have great resonance throughout the world."

It stresses: "Special importance must be attached to the call made in the report by Comrade Chou En-lai for 'strengthening our unity with the proletariat and the oppressed people and nations of the whole world and with all countries subjected to imperialist aggression, subversion, interference, control or bullying and forming the broadest united front against imperialism, colonialism and neo-colonialism, and in particular, against the hegemonism of the two superpowers — the U.S. and the U.S.S.R.' This call will be a powerful encouragement to the revolutionary struggle against imperialism and for national and social liberation being waged by the peoples of the world."

The message stresses: "Our Party highly appreciates the call in the same report for 'uniting with all genuine Marxist-Leninist Parties and organizations the world over, and carrying the struggle against modern revisionism through to the end.' We hold that the unity of the genuine Marxist-Leninists is today a task of first importance for the advance of world revolution. Without the strictest unity of the genuine Marxist-Leninists, it is impossible to defeat U.S. imperialism, Russian social-imperialism, the reactionaries and all kinds of revisionists. This is a task for all of us. We are sure that, so long as we support these principles, serve our people unselfishly, and dare to combat these enemies, we will be able to consolidate this unity which will bury all the exploiters and oppressors of our peoples."

The message concludes: "Our people and the people of China have the same enemies: U.S. imperialism, Russian social-imperialism, the reactionaries and revisionists. Therefore, your victories in the struggle against these enemies constitute a direct support to the struggle which the Chilean people are waging against the same enemies. For this reason, all the Chileans — the democrats, patriots, and revolutionaries — greet the successful convocation of the Tenth National Congress of the Communist Party of China, which without doubt will mark a great step forward in the Chinese people's magnificent and historic struggle."
