# Bronx High Schools Demonstrate

On Thursday, May 7, 500 Bronx high school students were attacked and many were savagely beaten by a mob of wild, racist pigs at the Arthur Avenue draft board. The Puerto Rican and Black students from Morris H.S. and Jane Adams H.S. were exercising their constitutional right (1st amendment) to assemble and peacefully demonstrate against the Cambodian Invasion and the Vietnamese War.

It is obvious that the pig power structure of NYC no longer recognizes any rights for the Puerto Rican and Black community. Students who had been picketing peacefully were chased as far as 4 blocks, beaten, and left bleeding on the ground. A sister was chased by 4 pigs in a car when she couldn't run anymore, they beat her to the ground and left her there. Another sister who didn't move fast enough was pinned up against a fence by a 6-foot tall pig who broke his club over her head. When a YOUNG LORD with medical supplies tried to help her, he was attacked by 2 more pigs. Another member of the YLO was also singled out and clubbed.

The draft board demonstration grew out of the struggle of Morris H.S. students to have a voice in the running of their school. Two weeks before, a member of the YLO was forbidden to speak to students and threatened with arrest, even though two classes and their teachers had invited him in to discuss the YLO 13-Point Program.

The students were angry and demanded to know why they couldn't invite speakers into their school. Doesn't education mean an exchange of ideas? Why was the school administration trying to prevent them from hearing a speaker who would talk about the realities of life in the Puerto Rican and Black community? What were they trying to hide? The Brothers and Sisters were demanding a true education of their culture, and an education that dealt with

the Puerto Rican and Black heritage and history of fighting against cultural and economic genocide. Point 6 of the YLO 13-Point Program says "We want a true education of our creole culture and language."

The Morris students drew up a list of demands and presented them to the principal, a Black "tom" who puts her career over the education of our people. The people were demanding the right to have a student-written and controlled newspaper (Morris has no newspaper so that Brothers and Sisters can communicate with each other and exchange ideas); to reproduce leaflets on their school's mimeograph machines, using their school's paper; to put up posters in their school; and to distribute leaflets and information inside their school. The administration doesn't want students to be able to communicate, to unite. A strong, united student body will not continue to listen to the racist, irrelevant teachings of people who neither respect nor love the Puerto Rican and Black people.

Although the elected student government approved the demands, the principal said she would not give up her right to run the school. The students took to the streets, on strike. We know, and the students know, that Morris H.S.

doesn't belong to the principal or her lackeys. Their job is to see that our people are prepared for the future; the future in a racist society that treats Puerto Ricans and Blacks as second-class citizens. If the schools do not function for our people, by giving them the skills and knowledges they need to fight this oppressive system, they should not function at all.

## ESTUDIANTES SE REBELAN

El Jueves, 7 de Mayo, 500 estudiantes de las escuelas superiores del Bronx fueron atacados viciosamente por un grupo de cochinos salvajes y locos en frente de las oficinas de la junta de ingreso del servicio militar obligatorio, en la avenida Arthur. Los estudiantes Puertorriqueños y Negros estaban utilizando su privilegio constitucional para demostrar pacíficamente contra la invasión de Cambodia y la guerra en VietNam.

Está claro que la estructura de poder de la ciudad de Nueva York ya no reconoce ninguno de los derechos de las comunidades Negras o Puertorriqueñas. Estudiantes que piquetaban pacíficamente fueron perseguidos por 4 cuadras, gopeados y tirados en la calle sangrando. Una hermana fue persiguida hasta un parque por un carro que tenía 4 cochinos adentro; cuando y no podía correr más la agarraron y la dejaron golpeada en el suelo. A otra hermana que no se movió suficiente ligero la pusieron de espaldas contra una cerca y un cochino que media 6 pies le rompió la macana en la cabeza. Un YOUNG LORD que tenía equipo médico no la pudo ayudar porque cuando se acercó 2 cochinos lo atacaron. Otro miembro de los YOUNG LORDS fue señalado y macanizado.

La demostración fue un resultado de la lucha en la escuela Morris por los estudiantes para tomar control de su escuela. Dos semanas ante, un miembro de la OYL fue prohibido hablar con los estudiantes a pesar de que dos clases y sus maestros lo invitaron a explicar el programa de la OYL.

Los estudiantes estaban furiosos y demandaron saber porque ellos no podían invitar oradores a su escuela. ¿No es la educación el cambio de ideas? Porque la administración no quiso que se hablará de las realidades de las comunidades Negras y puertorriqueñas? Las hermanas y los hermanos demandaban una verdadera educación sobre su cultura y una educación que trataría con la historia de años de lucha que los Puertorriqueños y los Negros han logrado en contra el genocidio cultural y económico. Punto #6 del Programa del OYL dice: Queremos una educación verdadera

## ABAJO CON MACHISMO!

Es una realidad muy bien conocida que en nuestra cultura Puertorriqueña los hombres casados son animados a tener otra mujer por el lado, o lo que nosotros llamamos "una corteja". Es un hecho de nuestra sociedad que tratamos de esconder, y todavía está ahí y claramente es opresivo para nuestras mujeres. La esposa está ahí para tener hijos y para mantener el nombre y honor de la familia. Por esto ella tiene que ser "Pura" (virgen) para casarse y mantenerse "pura" durante el resto de su vida cual quiere decir no tener placer sexual. La esposa obligadamente tiene que tener hijos para realizar el concepto de la virilidad del hombre y para engrandecer su posición dentro de la sociedad puertorriqueña. La corteja se convierte en su instrumento sexual. El hombre puede establecerla en otra casa, pagándole la renta, comprándole la comida, y pagándole los biles. El hombre puede tener hijos con esta mujer pero son mirados como el producto de una relación sexual. Ambas mujeres tienen que ser fieles al hombre. Ambas mujeres son explotadas; ninguna de las dos son permitidas a desarrollarse como seres humanas completas. Las dos son forzadas a ser dependientes a un hombre por su estatura. También los hijos de ambas mujeres crecen muy confundidos y inseguros y desarrollan actitudes negativas sobre el papel y función de la mujer, tanto como un

concepto confuso de lo que es ser hombre.

Nosotros decimos que el hecho de nuestros hombres tener cortezas oprimen a las mujeres. El décimo punto de la organización de los Young Lords dice "Queremos igualdad para la mujer. Machismo tiene que ser revolucionario y no opresivo." La explotación de la mujer Puertorriqueña de parte del hombre Puertorriqueño tiene que parar; los hombres puertorriqueños tienen que darse cuenta que el machismo es una extensión del capitalismo y se tiene que derrotar. La mujer puertorriqueña tiene que darse cuenta que el opresor principal es el capitalismo de los estados unidos.

El pueblo Puertorriqueño, no puede permitir que este sistema decadente racista dirija nuestras vidas porque nos destruye. Por esto, tenemos que destruirlo primero. Nosotros tenemos que controlar nuestros propios destinos y determinar nuestras vidas para ser libres a crear un sistema nuevo y equitativo para ambos, la mujer y el hombre. Nuestra gente tiene que coger el fusil y decirle al puer, BASTA YA!

# HRUM: HEALTH WORKER ORGANIZATION

The Puerto Rican and Black worker in the Human Services is known as an assistant, assistant to the teacher, the assistant to the welfare investigator, and in the hospitals we are the assistants to the doctors, nurses, social workers, etc.

As assistants (sophisticated word for slave) we are totally oppressed and unfortunately at the same time we assist in the oppression of our people.

Eighty per cent of the hospital workers are Puerto Rican and Black—residents of the poorest communities. As Puerto Ricans and Black workers in the emergency rooms and clinics, we see what oppression in the hospital is like, the inferior medical attention our neighbors are subjected to or obligated to accept. The worker also gets the same treatment. The enemy effectively divides the people and the worker finds himself each day divided more and more into two categories: the worker that identifies with the hospital and defends the oppressive, abusive and racist thieving doctors; the worker that does not turn his back on his people and defends the patients and his co-workers above everything else.

The newly formed Health Revolutionary Unity Movement is in the second category. The organization was formed for two reasons: we know that the health system will not change unless we push that necessary change? the unions 1199 and District Council 37, even though progressive in the question of salaries, do not fight against the conditions imposed on the workers nor the quality of the medical services our people are receiving.

Many struggles have risen in the hospitals by revolutionary Puerto Rican and Black workers. During one of these struggles less than a year ago in Lincoln Hospital, the workers took over the mental health services demanding community control of the services. Also in a dump of a clinic in the Lower East Side, the Gouverneur Clinic, a similar struggle was waged.

Although the struggles have not triumphed significantly they have helped us to learn self-organization.

The organization is composed of Puerto Rican and Black workers of Metropolitan, Lincoln, Gouverneur hospitals and NENA Health Center among many others.

We insist that the time has come to act against a system that enriches itself at the

expense of our people.

So that our struggle can be effective, we must make clear our purposes. That is why the Health Revolutionary Unity Movement uses the 10-Point Program as their principal guide. Our efforts have been demonstrated with the educational newspaper, "For the People's Health." In addition, we work in complete solidarity with the organizations that have shown their commitment to serve and protest the exploitation and oppression of our people, such as: the Young Lords Organization and the Black Panther Party.

In the next edition of "For the People's Health" we shall announce our first general meeting. We invite all workers to attend and in that way join the Health Revolutionary Unity Movement.

In unity, there is strength? the same enemy of the Cambodian people is found in the hospitals.

## TRABAJADORES SE ORGANIZAN

El trabajador Puertorriqueño y Negro en los servicios humanos es conocido como asistente, el asistente al maestro, el asistente al Investigador de Welfare, y en los hospitales somos los asistentes al doctor, enfermera, trabajadora de Servicios Sociales, etc. Como asistente (palabra sofisticada para esclavo) somos totalmente oprimidos aunque desgraciadamente a la misma vez asistimos en la opresión de nuestra gente.

El 80% de los trabajadores en los hospitales son Puertorriqueños y Negros residentes de las comunidades más pobres. Como Puertorriqueños y Negros trabajando en las salas de emergencia o clínicas vemos bien lo que es la opresión en los hospitales: la atención médica inferior que se ven nuestros vecinos obligados aceptar. El trabajador también pasa por el mismo tratamiento.

El enemigo divide muy efectivamente a la gente, y los trabajadores se encuentran cada

dia mas y mas divididos en dos categorías:

1) el trabajador que se identifica con el hospital y defiende a los opresores, al doctor abusador—pillo, racista.

2) el trabajador que no deja a su pueblo y defiende al paciente y a su compañero por encima de todo.

El Movimiento Revolucionario Unitario de Salud (HRUM) nuevamente formado cae en la segunda categoría. La Organización fue formado principalmente por do... razones. Sabemos que el sistema de salud no cambiara al menos que nosotros no obligemos ese cambio necesario. Las uniones 1199 Dist 37 aunque progresista en cuestión de salarios, no se openen a las condiciones en que se encuentran los trabajadores ni se preocupan con la calidad de servicios médicos para nuestro pueblo.

Entre estas luchas recordamos que hace poco mas de un año en el hospital Lincoln los trabajadores ocuparon los edificios de Servicios Salud Mental con demandas de control comunal de esos servicios. También en una ratonera de clínica en el bajo Manhattan,

La clínica Gouverneur, se llevó a cabo similar lucha. Aunque las luchas no han sido significativamente triunfante nos han ayudado a comprender la necesidad de organización propia.

La organización se compone de trabajadores Puertorriqueños y Negros del hospital Metropolitan, Lincoln, Gouverneur,

NENA Health Center, entre muchos otros. Insistimos de que ha llegado el tiempo para actuar en contra de un sistema que enriquece mientras nuestra gente muere.

Para que nuestra lucha sea efectiva tenemos que hacer claro nuestros propósitos. Por lo tanto el Movimiento Revolucionario Unitario de Salud usa el programa de diez puntos de salud como su guía principal. Nuestros esfuerzos se han demostrado con el Periódico educativo "Para La Salud Del Pueblo." En adición trabajamos en completa solidaridad con las organizaciones que han demostrado su devoción a servir y proteger nuestros pueblos explotados—oprimidos. La organización de LOS YOUNG LORDS y Las Panteras Negras han demostrado esta devoción.

En la próxima edición del "Para La Salud Del Pueblo", anunciaremos nuestro primer mitin general. Invitamos a todos los trabajadores que vengan y así pues ingresar al Movimiento Revolucionario Unitario de Salud. En la Unión está la fuerza.

# LOLITA LEBRON Y COMPAÑEROS LUCHAN POR PR

El 1 de Marzo del 1954, miembros de la cámara de representantes de los e.u. estaban discutiendo su imperio, haciendo decisiones que afectarían gente en todas partes del mundo. Uno de los topicos que se iba a discutir ese día era la posición del distrito Chamízal entre tejas y mejico; el gobierno mexicano quería devuelto ese distrito y los e.u. no se lo quería dar. Los gobernantes del imperio de los e.u. también, iban a discutir la posición de Puerto Rico porque nuestra nación todavía estaba reaccionando a la revolución del 1950. Eran las doce del medio día cuando una mujer y tres hombres se pararon en la galería de espectadores. La mujer, bajita y delgada, agarró su revólver, un 45 automático, y con dos manos disparó los primeros tiros y siguió hasta que lo vacío. Sus tres compañeros hicieron igual y por cinco minutos dispararon hacia bajo del salón de la casa. Los gordos viejos dirigentes auto-proclamados parecían gallinas con las cabezas cortadas corriendo en todas direcciones y muertos del miedo. Mientras los cuatro vaciaban sus pistolas los guardias se les acercaron. Lolita Lebron desenvolvió la bandera Puertorriqueña y se la envolvió en sus brazos y grito para que el mundo la oyera "QUE VIVA PUERTO RICO LIBRE".

Lolita Lebron, 31 años; Rafael Cancel Miranda, 25 años; Irving Flores Rodríguez, 23 años; y Andres Figueroa Cordero, 23 años; dieron un golpe contra el poder colonial de los e.u. ese día que solo ha sido igualado en atrevimiento, valor y dedicación a la causa de Liberación de la nación Puertorriqueña, por el atento a asesinato al presidente Truman en el 1950 por Oscar Collazo y Griselda Torresola. Ellos llegaron a herir seriamente a cinco congresistas ese día incluso a uno de Nueva York. Lo que intentaban era enseñarle al congreso de los e.u. (de cuál el comité de asuntos insulares y la cámara de asuntos insulares y territoriales, controlaban todo aspecto de la vida de Puerto Rico) que la gente de Puerto Rico preferiría morir luchando por su liberación antes que estar sentados tomando aire y velando los norteamerikanos decidido nuestras vidas y destinos.

En muchas maneras, estos cuatro Borinquenos dieron un fuerte golpe, no solo para Puerto Rico pero también para todos los pueblos del tercer mundo aquí en los estados unidos y alrededor del mundo. Uno de los cuatro, Rafael Cancel Miranda era por mucho tiempo un luchador de liberación por el pueblo Afro Americano aquí en los estados unidos. El había sido arrestado en Puerto Rico por rehusar ingresarse al servicio militar obligatorio de los estados unidos y fue sentenciado a tres años de prisión. Durante el tiempo en Atlanta, Tallahasse, y otras prisiones federales, él activamente trató de organizar hermanos negros para luchar contra el racismo y opresión cual ellos enfrentaban más que otros prisioneros. Como resultado de su efectividad en sus actividades y su valor (él, frecuentemente patrulla la jara por ser abusadores con él y sus hermanos) lo cambiaron de prisión a prisión y muchas veces lo mantienen en solitaria.

Esto, además de que en ese día discutían la tierra chamízal entre mejico y los estados unidos causó que los pueblos de América Latina nombraran a los cuatro guerreros puertorriqueños, "Los Caballeros de la Raza". Esto quizo decir que el golpe no fue solo para los puertorriqueños pero también para todos los pueblos del tercer mundo (La raza).

Lolita, Rafael, Andres y Irving eran trabajadores humildes quienes vivían en nueva york y desarrollaban a la gente del Partido Nacionalista aquí. Lolita Lebron, la valiente líder del grupo, trabajaba en una fábrica en nueva york como la mayoría de nuestras hermanas. Ella tenía dos hijos y al tiempo del ataque era secretaria principal de la Junta en Nueva York. Era delgada y bajita (como 4 pies con 10 pulgadas en estatura 95 libras) pero tenía el valor y la energía de diez personas. Desde el atento a la revolución en el 1950, había sido bien activa en las campañas

de publicidad y de levantar fondos para la libertad de prisioneros políticos. También trabajo para evitar el asesinato de Oscar Collazo en el sillín eléctrica.

Rafael Cancel Miranda era un hermano alto (6 pies con 2 pulgadas) conocido por todo el Partido Nacionalista por su fuerza, (intensa) actividad política, y odio para el opresor norteamericano. Muchas veces bofetaba a gringos o jara colonial que faltara respeto a o abusara con nuestra gente. Era lijero de mano y como se vio en la acción de la casa de representantes, lijero con su pistola. Rafael también tenía dos hijos y al tiempo del ataque trabajaba, igual que Lolita, en una fábrica de Nueva York.

Andrés Figueroa Cordero, era un hermano bajito, cojo. Trabajó por muchos años en la bodega de Pedro y Julia en la esquina de la 103 y park ave, como carnicero. El era de la junta del Partido Nacionalista en nueva york como también lo era Irving Flores, y fue muy activo durante la campaña de conseguir libertad para los prisioneros políticos del 1950.

Como de costumbre, los Estados Unidos uso este acto de liberación como excusa para oprimir más a los Puertorriqueños, especialmente a esos que trabajaban activamente en las campañas para la liberación de los prisioneros políticos del 1950.

## ACTO HEROICO

Con Lolita, Rafael, Andres, y Irving once otros hermanos y hermanas Borinquenos de Nueva York fueron arrestados y acusados de conspiración contra el gobierno de los estados unidos. En Puerto Rico, Don Pedro Albizu Campos, fue encarcelado, por decirle a un reportero que los cuatro patriotas habían "realizado un acto sublime de heroísmo". Don Pedro había sido perdonado después de haber servido cuatro años de una sentencia a muerte por su papel en la revolución del 1950. Pero ahora, en contra de sus propias leyes pendejas, el alcalde, gobernado colonial Luis Muñoz Marin retractó el perdón y encarceló a Don Pedro por haber hecho una declaración pública. Permaneció encarcelado hasta que asesinado con "tratamientos" en el 1965.

Conrad Lynn y Mark Lane fueron entre los abogados que defendieron "Los Caballeros de la Raza" y los otros once hermanos y hermanas. Después de mucha propaganda sobre "la violenta conspiración contra el gobierno," Lolita Lebron fue sentenciada a de 25 a 50 años de prisión, y Rafael Cancel Miranda, Irving Flores Rodriguez y Andres

Figueroa Cordero a 25 hasta 75 años de prisión. Los cuatro todavía están presos en prisiones federales, Lolita en Virginia y los tres hermanos en Leavenworth, Kansas. Los otros once hermanos y hermanas fueron sentenciados a de 6 a 10 años y varios de ellos están fuera bajo palabra o están cumpliendo con sus sentencias ahora.

## LUCHA ARMADA

La lección que tenemos que aprender de nuestros hermanos y hermanas es que nosotros los Puertorriqueños no somos Neoyorquinos ni nada de esa mierda. Somos Borinquenos aunque no nos han enseñado de nuestros guerreros, de nuestra historia, ni de nuestra isla. Más importante, debemos entender que todo lo que pasa en nuestra patria nos afecta aquí, igualmente que todo lo que nosotros hacemos aquí afecta allá, como lo que nuestros compatriotas hicieron en la casa de representantes afecta nuestra gente allá. Ellos nos enseñaron que aquí tenemos que levantar la pistola de Lolita, Rafael, y Oscar Collazo, y seguir el camino así a la liberación señalada por Don Pedro Albizu Campos: Lucha Armada. Lolita y los hermanos creían firmemente y practicaban las enseñanzas de Albizu, "para quitarnos la patria tienen que quitarnos la vida," y "La patria es Valor y Sacrificio." Estas frases expresan las experiencias de nuestro pueblo colonizado que lleva 72 años de lucha tratando de libertarnos del imperialismo Norte Amerikkano. Sino no nos espabilamos con las palabras de nuestras hermanas y hermanos caídos, nos vamos a volver la última generación de Puertorriqueños, acabada por el genocidio mientras vacilamos, nos arrebatamos y chuliamos programas contra la pobreza.

De acuerdo con el punto numero 9 del programa de los YOUNG LORDS (Queremos la libertad de todo prisionero político), demandamos la libertad inmediata de "Los Caballeros de la Raza." Lolita Lebron, Rafael Cancel Miranda, Irving Flores Rodriguez, y Andres Figueroa Cordero tienen que ser soltados porque ellos no han cometido crimen ninguno, solo han tratado de liberarnos de la dominación colonial.

# LOLITA LEBRON

## Puerto Rican Liberation Fighter

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On March 1, 1954, the members of the U.S. House of Representatives were busily discussing their empire, making decisions that would affect people the world over. One of the topics to be discussed that day was the status of the Chamizal district between Texas and Mexico, that the Mexican government wanted back (and which the U.S. did not want to give up). The rulers of the United States Empire were also going to discuss Puerto Rico that day since our nation was still reacting to the attempted revolution of 1950. It was twelve noon when a woman and three men stood up in the spectators gallery. The small, slender woman grabbed her .45 automatic with both hands, fired the first shots and kept on going until her clip was empty. Her three companions did the same and for the five minutes that they shot down into the house floor, the fat, old, self-proclaimed rulers, looked like chickens with their heads cut off running in every direction, and scared to death. As all four emptied their guns, and the house guards came at them, Lolita Lebron, unfurled the Puerto Rican flag, wrapped it around her arms and yelled for the world to hear, "QUE VIVA PUERTO RICO LIBRE."

Lolita Lebron, 31, Rafael Cancel Miranda, 25, Irving Flores Rodriguez, 23, and Andres Figueroa Cordero, 23, struck a blow against the United States colonial power that day that is only equalled in its daring, courage, and dedication to the cause of the liberation of the Puerto Rican nation by the attempted assassination of President Truman in 1950 by Oscar Collazo and Grisellio Torresola. They managed to wound five congressmen that day (including one from New York very seriously). Their intent was to show the United States Congress (whose House Committee on Insular Affairs and Senate Committee on Territorial and Insular Affairs rule every aspect of Puerto Rican life) that the people of Puerto Rico would rather die fighting for our liberation than sit idly by and watch our destinies and lives decided and determined by northamerikkkan rulers.

### BLOW FOR ALL

### THIRD WORLD

In many ways those four Borinquenos struck a blow not only for Puerto Rico but for all Third World people in the United States and around the planet. One of the four, Rafael Cancel Miranda had long been an advocate of liberation for Afro-American people in the United States. He had been arrested in Puerto Rico in 1948 for refusing to be drafted into the U.S. Army and had been sentenced to three years in jail. During his time in the Atlanta, Tallahassee, and other federal prisons, he actively tried to organize black brothers to fight against the racism and oppression that they faced more than other prisoners. Because of the effectiveness of his activities and his courage (he frequently kicked guards in their asses for abusing him or his brothers), he spent most of his time being transferred from one jail to another or being kept in solitary.

### PIG OF THE WEEK

This week's PIG OF THE WEEK award goes to Spiro T. Agnew, the vice president of the United States of Amerikkka. Spiro Agnew should get an extra stripe for speeding up the process of fascism in this country. Spiro should be given due credit (people tried to discredit him by giving the honor to Gov. Daley in Chicago) for being the first governor to give orders to the pig department to "shoot to kill" all looters during riots. This was in 1968 when he was governor of Maryland. Add to this list of vices besides fascism, censorship of the press, a love of war and an undying devotion to stop "communism" by erasing all Third World people from the face of the earth.

Let it never be said that Spiro T. Agnew does not deserve his award as PIG OF THE WEEK. Watch him in the future—he shows true potential to become pig of ALL times!

As always, the United States treated this act of liberation as an excuse to repress more Puerto Ricans, especially those who had been active in the campaigns to free the political prisoners of 1950. Along with Lolita, Rafael, Andres, and Irving, eleven other Boricuas from New York were charged with attempting to overthrow the government of the United States. In Puerto Rico, Don Pedro Albizu Campos, was sent to jail for saying to a reporter that the four patriots had "realized an act of sublime heroism." Don Pedro had been pardoned after serving four years of a life sentence for his role in the revolution of 1950. But now, through a blatant violation of their own jive laws, colonial puppet governor Luis Munoz Marin retracted the pardon and sent Don Pedro back to jail just for making a public statement. He stayed in jail until he was killed through "treatments" in 1965.



This plus the fact that the Chamizal land between Mexico and the United States was being discussed that day caused people all over Latin America to label the four Puerto Rican warriors, "LOS CABALLEROS DE LA RAZA." This meant that they struck a blow not only for Puerto Rico but for all people of the Third World (La Raza).

Lolita, Rafael, Andres, and Irving were all Puerto Ricans of humble working backgrounds who had been living in New York and building up the Nationalist Party Junta (mission) here. Lolita Lebron, the valiant leader of the group, worked in a factory in New York just like most of our sisters still do. She had two children and at the time of the attack was head secretary of the Junta in New York City. She was small in size (about 4 feet, 10 inches - 95 pounds) but had the courage and energy of ten people. Since the attempted revolution in 1950, she had been active in the publicity and fund raising campaigns to free the political prisoners and keep Oscar Collazo from being murdered in the electric chair.

Rafael Cancel Miranda was a tall (6 feet, 2 inches) brother who was known throughout the Nationalist Party for his strength, intense political activity, and hatred of the northamerikkkan oppressor. He often smacked gringos or colonial police who showed disrespect or abused our people. He was fast with his hands and as the House of Representatives action showed, fast with a gun. Rafael also had two children and at the time of the attack was, like Lolita, working in one of New York City's sweat shops.

Andres Figueroa Cordero, was a short brother who walked with a limp. He had worked for years at Pedro and Julia's bodega on the corner of 103rd Street and Park Avenue as a butcher. He was a cadre of the Nationalist Party Junta in New York and like Irving Flores, also a cadre, was very active in doing the work of trying to free all of the political prisoners that had been jailed in 1950.

### 50 YEARS IN JAIL

Conrad Lynn and Mark Lane were among the many lawyers who defended "LOS CABALLEROS DE LA RAZA" and the eleven other brothers and sisters. After much propaganda about the "violent attempt to overthrow the government," the court sentenced Lolita Lebron to 25 to 50 years in jail; and Rafael Cancel Miranda, Irving Flores Rodriguez, and Andres Figueroa Cordero to 25 to 75 years in jail. All four are still in federal jails, with Lolita in Virginia and the three brothers in Leavenworth, Kansas. The other eleven brothers and sisters were given 6 to 10 years, and some of them are out on parole or done with their sentences now.

The lessons that we must learn from our valiant sister and brothers is that we Puerto Ricans in the United States are not New Yoricans or any such bullshit non-people. We are Borinquenos, whether or not we have been taught about our warriors, our history and our island. Most importantly, we should understand that everything that happens in our country affects us here, and likewise everything we do here, as our compatriots did in the House of Reps, affects our people there. They showed us that it is up to us here to pick up the gun from Lolita, Rafael, and Oscar Collazo, and follow the path towards liberation and the brothers firmly believed and practiced the teachings of Albizu that "In order to take our nation, they must first take our lives," and "The Nation is Valor and Sacrifice." These are not empty words or mere slogans. They express the experiences of our colonized people who have struggled for 72 years to free us from United States imperialist control. Unless we heed the words of our fallen brothers and sisters, we will become the last generation of Puerto Ricans who bugaloed, shot-up, or poverty-pimped their time away while genocide was being brought down on us.

In accordance with point number 9 of the YLO Program (We want freedom for all political prisoners), we demand the release of "LOS CABALLEROS DE LA RAZA." Lolita Lebron, Rafael Cancel Miranda, Irving Flores Rodriguez, and Andres Figueroa Cordero must be set free for they have committed no crime, but have instead tried to liberate us from colonial domination.



Cuando uno piensa de la historia de la gente Negra y Puertorriquena, uno puede ver bien claro el intento de robarnos nuestra cultura. Este intento obvio de quitarnos nuestra cultura y hacernos menos que humano se hace mintiendoles de la realidad de nuestros heroes Latinos y Negros.

Malcolm X, nacido en amerikkka, creyente de la religion Muslim, fue uno de los pocos hermanos que pudo estirarse de la degradacion en cual nosotros, los Puertorriquenos y Negros nos encontramos aqui en Babylonia. El empezo a hablar de nuestra situacion en terminos honestos y realsticos.

Cuando Malcom hablaba en los clubes de baile o en las esquinas, el nunca discutia cual religion era mejor, quien era mas Negro que quien, o cual organizacion era mejor que la otra, ni quien era mas Puertorriqueno que quien. El solo hablaba de nuestra necesidad basica—la de controlar la tierra. Cuando hablamos de tierra, la conversacion naturalmente se extiende a revolution. Revolution con sangre. Negros y Puertorriquenos siempre han luchado para ser libres y obtener control de sus vidas. Hemos tratado todas las maneras posibles y no hemos logrado nada. Por eso es que alfora estamos hablando de revolution. Sabemos que este sistema nunca nos permitira controlar nuestra tierra. Lo que tenemos que aprender ahora es que tendramos que luchar por ese control; Malcolm sabia esto. El dijo: "No podemos cantar de la question de tierra—Tenemos que luchar para obtenerla."

Malcolm miro hacia la situacion de los hermanos y las hermanas VietNameses y vio lo que ellos estaban haciendo sobre la question de su libertad. Revoluciones son sangrientas, y Malcolm vio que aparte de los veteranos de guerra, casi nadie en amerikkka ha visto la muerte de masas de gente. Desde que el "Sur-bajo" y el "Sur-norte" pelearon no se ha visto ninguna guerra en amerikkka propia. Los amerikkkanos hacen todo su trabajo sucio fuera donde los ojos de "la mayoria callada" no lo vean.

La gente de amerikkka se afician cuando uno habla de muerte y violencia fisica pero no se dan cuenta que su vida entera tiene base en la violencia. Miren a VietNam, a Cambodia, a Puerto Rico, y a nuestras comunidades aqui mismo en amerikkka.

Alguna gente todavia se ponen a leer libros sobre "Pensamiento Revolucionario" o aparecen en todas las reuniones pensando que eso es lo unico que tienen que hacer. Pero, que van a hacer cuando no hayan mas libros?

Empezando el Martes, Mayo 19, va haber una reunion y un festival de cinco dias honrando a Malcolm, uno de los heroes mas valiente de cual los pueblos Negro y Puertorriqueno pueden ser orgullosos. La parada empieza a las doce de la tarde. Saliran de la calle 160 y Broadway.



## MALCOLM X

When one looks back at the history of Black and Puerto Rican people in relation to white western amerikkka, one can see the attempt to westernize us and erase our culture. The obvious attempt to take away our culture and dehumanize us is really an attempt to lie about our Latin and Black heroes.

Malcolm X, an Orthodox Muslim, born in amerikkka, was one of the few brothers to rise out of the degradation that all Blacks and Puerto Ricans experience in Babylon. He began to talk about our situation honestly and realistically.



When Malcolm spoke in ballrooms or on street corners, he would never argue over whose religion was better, over who was blacker, over whose organization was better, or over who is more Puerto Rican than who. He would rap about our most basic need—control of land (Point #7 of the Y.L.O. program states: We want community control of our institutions and land). Without the control of the land that you eat, sleep, work, worship, live or learn on, your religion is not yours, the products of your work are not yours, the teachings of your schools are not yours, your lives are not yours and in reality, you are nothing but "20th century slaves"; as Malcolm puts it.

When talking about land, the conversation naturally leads to revolution. Bloody revolution. Blacks and Puerto Ricans have always struggled to be free and to control their own lives. We have tried every way possible and we have not gotten anywhere. That is why at this point we are talking about revolution. We know that this system will never allow us to control our land. What we have to learn now is that we have to fight for it. Malcolm knew this. He said, "You can't sing up on some land. You have to swing up on it."

Malcolm knew enough to look at the Vietnamese (so-called VietCong) brothers and sisters across the sea and see what they were doing about their freedom. Revolutions are bloody and Malcolm realized that


aside from war veterans, very few amerikkans know what mass killing looks like. There hasn't been a war in amerikkka since the economic quarrel between "down-South" and "up-South"—amerikkka does all its dirty work outside of amerikkka where the "silent majority" cannot see it.

People in amerikkka have become hung-up on death and physical violence although their whole world is based on violence. Look at Vietnam, Cambodia, Puerto Rico, and our own communities here in amerikkka.

Malcolm tried to educate the masses of the people. Some listened, and some didn't. The revolutionary organizations of today are educating. Some people are listening, and some aren't. Some people are still running around buying the latest book on "Revolutionary Thought," or attending every rally thinking that that is ALL that has to be done. Well, how you going to spend your time when there are no more "Books of the Month?"

Beginning on Tuesday, May 19, there will be a rally and 5-day festival in honor of Malcolm, one of the greatest heroes that Black and Puerto Rican people have to be proud of. The parade will begin at 12:00 noon. It will start at 160th and Broadway.

## Free Clothes FOR THE PEOPLE

The YOUNG LORDS ORGANIZATION has been running a series of Free Clothing Drives. The latest one was held on April 25, 1970, when over 300 mothers came and got clothes and kitchen utensils.

Our cry is a very simple and logical one. Puerto Ricans came to this country hoping to get a decent job and to provide for their families, but it didn't take long to find out that the amerikkkan dream that was publicized so nicely on our island, turned out to be the amerikkkan nightmare.

We live in the worst housing, and have to pay the most rent. We work the hardest and longest under the most inhumane conditions, yet we don't make enough bread to buy clothes for our children to go to school. We have to see our families live on rice and beans and crap all week.

As servants of the people (Revolutionaries), we have committed ourselves wholeheartedly to the development of our Nation of Borinquen and all humanity. We understand that our people can only be educated through observation and participation. The YLO arrived at this conclusion not because we think that people are stupid, but because so many groups or individuals have used us so much—like politicians use workers—that even our own people didn't give a damn about listening to the LORDS' political program. We had to SHOW our people what we were all about, and not TALK so much. After seeing what we were all about by example, our people got involved, at first in El Barrio, in the struggle for liberation. Soon, all Puerto Ricans will join in, because it will take all of us to free ourselves from the mental and physical chains this government has us under.

Our task in the YLO is to make our people conscious of the crimes committed against us by the fascist, racist, money-hungry capitalists. We decided to begin a free clothing program when the Department of Welfare cut the checks to 66¢ a day in New York City and our younger brothers and sisters had to go to school with three year old clothing. Also the YLO is educating everybody to the fact that our people are the ones that make those clothes at the garment center and then have to pay for them, when they are rightfully ours!

Not only that, but the mere fact that billions of dollars are spent to wage a war of aggression against other human beings, and then they say that they don't have enough money to provide clothing for our people (not even providing decent jobs so that we can pay for the damn rags).

The 13th point of the YLO Program and

Platform says: "We want a Socialist Society." We understand that the only way all of the things that are necessary for a human being to exist in this technological society can be provided is by taking control of the institutions, the government, the life and death of our people. This can only be done by organizing ourselves into a solid group of people that are armed and will put their lives on the line for the interests of the Poor and Oppressed People of the World. Revolution.



# YLO BRONX BRANCH

The YOUNG LORDS ORGANIZATION has been in existence, in New York State, for almost a year now, and our first concern during this year was to establish a firm base in El Barrio, our state headquarters. Had we spread out too fast all over the city we would have faced getting our asses kicked in by the pigs who were coming down hard on us. Instead, we have concentrated on educating and organizing our people, always keeping in mind, that our immediate goal was to expand our Organization. Having finally established our base in El Barrio, we opened a branch in the Bronx. The new office, situated at 949 Longwood Avenue (corner of Kelly St.), was opened early this April and will continue the programs started in El Barrio. More than this, it will begin programs relevant to the people in the Bronx area, it will also serve as a Latin Community News Service called "Palante" in which international revolutionary news will be included, and distributed to the people of the community. This last function of the YLO came about, after we found that many of the liberation struggles undertaken by peoples in other countries are not known to people in this country, due to press "censorship" of revolutionary news.

The office is situated in the heart of an area much like El Barrio. Our warm brothers and sisters here are deep into Puerto Ricaness and political awareness. Our recruitment is growing rapidly and many brothers and sisters are offering us their services, making us a part of their everyday life.

We constantly develop new methods of serving our people and we realize that we must be wherever our people are. No matter where we live, the man is there too, ready to oppress and exploit us. This

reality has especially come close to home the few weeks we've been in the Bronx through the graft that runs rampant everywhere we look. There are police cars which patrol the area heavily, if for no other reason than for the money they collect from store owners who are forced to supply the pigs with their daily fee. The pigs, in turn, promise to protect the

## Y L O Free Breakfast Program

When we were young, we'd often go to school hungry and sit in class, waiting for lunchtime to come. The pangs of hunger would be so great that we'd be unable to place our minds on our studies. Eventually what would happen was that the teacher would end up calling us stupid, ignorant, or people unwilling to learn. Today, the YLO is attempting to deal with the problems of the community, and most important among these problems, is the hunger undergone by many of our people, among them most especially, the young children. The YOUNG LORDS ORGANIZATION Free Breakfast Program is providing the primary necessity of life to dozens of our children—food. It's function is so essential that Felipe Luciano, our state chairman, has stated that, "Any LORD who refuses for some insufficient reason to relate to the breakfast program, is unworthy of being considered a LORD."

# THE VOTE OR THE GUN?

The Young Lords Organization is a revolutionary political party fighting for the liberation of Puerto Ricans and all oppressed people. We are the answer to the 400 year need of Latinos for a political party to lead our struggle for liberation.

From the first invasion of Borinquen by Christopher Columbus in November, 1493, our people have been resisting the foot on their back. The Tainos fought the Spanish adventurers and money-hungry pirates. The people of the Yoruba Nation, kidnapped from their African homeland, resisted the Spanish slave traders, and constantly rebelled for their freedom.

In 1868, the Puerto Rican people rose up for the first time as a nation. In El Grito de Lares, we were saying— we are not Spaniards. We are the mixture of African and Indian, born in Borinquen, speaking Spanish. We are Puerto Ricans, an island nation, oppressed by the Spanish empire.

Led by Ramon Emeterio Betances, Segundo Ruiz Belvis, and Manuel Rojas, first patriots we took up arms for

armed struggle would free our nation. Don Pedro Albizu Campos, leader of the Party said, "The electoral fight is a regular farce to keep the Puerto Rican family divided." The Nationalist Party, like the secret parties of 1868, said "Basta Ya" to the vendepatrias (traitors) of our history. It said there are two alternatives—slavery or freedom/ colony or independent nation/ oppressed or liberated. From 1932 to 1954 the second War of Independence was waged. The Ponce Massacre, the battles of 1950, the attack on Truman and Congress were all battles of that war.

Our motto is serve and protect. We serve the needs of our people and educate them that only through revolution will all our needs be met. Only through organized change will we end addiction, eliminate landlords, build new cooperative housing, provide jobs for all, assure decent health for everyone, end all wars, and achieve independence for Puerto Rico.

Our party defends our people from greedy businessmen, racist teaching systems, rats and roaches, disease, police brutality, robbery and murder.

No matter how many promises they make or what they do, the other political parties will never give you freedom. Freedom is taken, not given.

That is why we organize. Whenever there are Puerto Ricans, there will be YOUNG LORDS. Wherever there is oppression

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independence. The revolution was defeated. But for the first time someone had tried to build a political organization to lead the people. In every city revolutionary juntas had been formed. They used names of secret societies to fool the Spanish police; names like La Torre del Viejo, Centro Bravo, Capa Prieto.

They had good leadership. They raised money, got arms, politicized the people. They understood that the enemy is well organized and that if the people wish to win their freedom, they too must be well organized and prepared to deal. The revolution was defeated, though, because it was not organized enough. The patriots did not have military training. An arms supply from The Dominican Republic never reached them. They did not go into the countryside where the poorest and greatest number of Puerto Ricans—the jibaros, the campesinos, were.

After the revolution, our only political parties all tried to work within the Spanish and then American political structure. The Puerto Rican Republican party of Barbosa, the Federal Party of Munoz Rivera, the Independence Party of Matienzo Cintron, all worked within the structure set up for Borinquen by the amerikkkan occupiers. Some of the parties wanted independence, but all of them accepted the amerikkkan invasion, and hoped to convince amerikkka to someday free our people.

While they talked, the U.S. destroyed our economy, impoverished our people, imposed citizenship, destroyed our farmland, set up amerikkkan governors to rule us, and put military bases on the island to guard their businesses against all Latinos.

Revolution is the most serious fu jobs. It is not an ego-trip or a party. When the people join in revolutionary war, they do so because they have been convinced by both actual conditions and political education that there is no other way out, that their lives and those of their family are threatened.

Revolution is a complete change an overturning of dead soil, a new way of life, with new government, new laws.

Revolution is not something we want to do. It is bloody and cruel, but it is something we have to do to live decently and free.

The Young Lords Organization is a revolutionary political party. We are the

the sell-out of vendepatria munoz Marin who organized the Popular Party and Puerto Ricans saying "Bread, land, liberty." He then made a deal with the Gringo; he would become the first Puerto Rican governor if he would agree not to push for independence and accept his puppet role. The biggest traitor in Puerto Rican history is this lackey., Luis Munoz Marin, who shipped our people by the hundreds of thousands to New York because he could not provide jobs for them; who taught our people to be white middle class americanos, when they were poor, oppressed boricuas; who destroyed the jibaro with operation bootstrap, moving thousands off the land into the slums of San Juan, and Ponce, and let all our money go to us, capitalists. He was the apostle of non-violence for profit.

## Electoral System

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In 1952, the Nationalist Party, after ten years of trying to win independence through electoral means, decided that only through war against the U.S. would Borinquen be free. The newspapers, radio, the assembly, the businesses and latifundias all were controlled by the U.S. There could not be free elections. Only

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Finally, the Nationalists Party was destroyed by its own internal problems, by its emphasis on immediate shootouts with police instead of organizing a guerrilla army to lead the nation in people's war in the countryside; by its failure to organize the Black Puerto Rican as well as lighter skinned boricuas, and by its failure to provide concrete programs to meet the immediate needs of the people.

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where will be armed people fighting for their dignity.

We are in the period where revolutionary education is more important than revolutionary war. We are in a period of preparation.

We have lost twice before. We will not lose again. We cannot lose again. The Puerto Rican nation is being destroyed by the Yanqui and our vendepatrias.

Desde 1932 hasta el 1954 la segunda guerra de independencia fue lanzada. La Masacre de Ponce, las batallas de esa guerra, la revolución del 1950, el ataque a Truman y el congreso, todas fueron batallas de esa guerra. Otra vez, los patrios fueron derrotados. Don Pedro fue encarcelado, esta vez para el resto de su vida. El Partido Nacionalista fue destrozado. Hubieron razones, por la derrota: la represión del gobierno gringo que encarceló y mato un sin numero de miembros del Partido Nacionalista como nixon-smith o munoz marin, quién era uno de los peleadores del Partido de las Panteras Negras; el trato del vendepatria munoz marin, quién organizó el partido popular, y Puertorriqueños diciendo "Pan, tierra, y libertad." El traidor mas grande en la historia de Puerto Rico es el alcahuete, luis munoz vendepatria marin, quién embarco a cientos de miles de Puertorriqueños a Nueva York porque no podía proveer empleo para ellos, quién enseñó a nuestra gente ser amerikkkanos blancos de clase media, cuando en actualidad eran pobres y oprimidos

Brazil is the richest nation in the world in natural resources. She has vast stretches of fertile land and forests that are still untouched. She holds within her enormous body an estimated 23% of the world's iron. She has 90 million people and is the fifth largest country in the world. Brazil has the world's largest coffee and sugar resources. Why the need for revolution?

Brazil is also one of the most nazi-like, murderous, poverty-stricken nations in latino amerikkka. (The reason oppressed people in the u.s. never hear about the murder and torture of students, workers, and peasants in Brazil is because the u.s. is the main cause of it.)

Instead of developing her own resources like coffee and sugar and iron, the native rich geared the economy toward producing consumer goods. Knowing that there was a lot of money to be gained in heavy industry like coal, iron and steel, the Brazilian capitalists forced the government, which they controlled, to borrow money from amerikkka and other foreign countries because they couldn't afford it. In doing so, these few (vendepatrias) sold their whole nation to the yanquis for a few dollars so that they could live in luxury. Today, 33% of the exports go to the u.s. and over 1/3 of the imports are from amerikkka.

The tourist ads never mention that the average income of Brazilians is under \$300. "Average income" means they added up the incomes of the few rich and middle class with the majority of poor people. If you only average the income of the poor peasants and factory workers it comes to \$100 every year. In addition, inflation is so heavy in Brazil that the dollar is almost worthless.

As a result of rapid industrialization, many poor Brazilians left the interior to migrate to the main cities, Sao Paulo, Rio de Janeiro, and Belo Horizonte. They left for two reasons: 1) The amerikkkan companies had stolen their land and then made them work on it as laborers at slave wages and 2) they felt that they could get better jobs, houses, and education in the cities.

What has resulted instead have been "favelas," Brazilian slums. Overcrowded, disease-ridden, and paid almost nothing for the work they do, the favela dwellers have begun to revolt. It is either revolution or certain death when 1/2 of the Brazilian population live in shacks made of cardboard, newspapers or corrugated metal.

The answer is revolution when 1/2 of the population can't read or write.

It must be violent revolution when 1/2 of all Brazilian babies die before their first birthday, and there is only one doctor for every 20,000 Brazilians.

### repression

But when you speak of revolution in Brazil, you must also speak of repression by the military. The impact of the nazis and facism since the 1930's has been felt heavily by latino amerikkka, particularly Brazil because it has been since that time that the right-wing military has controlled Brazil whether they've been in power or not. Since 1945, every president has had to be approved and backed up by the generals to stay in office. The last president — murderer-dictator, costa e silva, continued the rule of Brazil by the military; 1/2 of his cabinet were from the armed forces) until his fortunate death in a helicopter crash. Today, Brazil is controlled by a 3-man military dictatorship. Censorship of the press, t.v. and mass media is the rule, not the exception. Recently, when students demonstrated against yanqui imperialism and for reforms on the campus, they were murdered; those who were captured alive were jailed and then tortured mercilessly. On April 10, the Brazilian Information Front released ten names of the brothers and sisters who had been politically assassinated by the generals in cold blood. Among those names was the name of Carlos Marighella, leader of National Liberation Action. Born December 5, 1911, the son of an Italian immigrant and a Black mother, Marighella at the age of 23 joined the Brazilian Communist Party when facist ideology entered Brazil and other countries of latino amerikkka as a result of hitler's rise to power. He was jailed, one time shot, beaten and tortured many times after that because of his leadership in opposition to the dictatorial government. Yet, he never revealed anything, never lost his desire to wrench Brazil from the hands of the yanquis and the latifundistas (big landowners).

However, as is common with many communist parties in capitalist countries, especially the u.s., the Brazilian Communist Party was more given to speeches, writing, power plays within the party and pacifism within the country than to revolution.

In his resignation letter to the party on December 10, 1966, Marighella stated that "Executive work has been limited to holding meetings, writing up political notes, and political reports. Thus there is no planned action, no activity centered around the struggle."

He further went on to declare that although the peasantry is the true balance of forces in the Brazilian revolution...the Executive Committee subordinates proletarian tactics to bourgeois tactics...

Also "after so much rhetoric about how the violence of the ruling classes must be met with the violence of arms, nothing has been done to make words match deeds. Commitment is forgotten and pacifism continues to be praised." Marighella then declared, "...I want to state publicly my commitment to revolutionary struggle, side by side with the masses....In Brazil the solution...can only be armed struggle, the revolutionary road, the preparation for armed insurrection by the people, with all the consequences and all the implications that follow from it."

### cuba's influence

Deeply influenced by the Cuban Revolution and Che's credo that "the job of every revolutionary is to make the revolution," Marighella in 1968 began to analyse the oppression of his people and to form a nucleus of revolutionaries to either win or die. With hardly any resources, this small band of warriors began revolutionary action. With small armed groups they ripped off everything they needed.

"We grew as a result of action, only and exclusively, as a result of revolutionary action."

It took Carlos Marighella years of witnessing and experiencing facism and military dictatorship to come to the conclusion that the only way to deal with reactionary violence was with revolutionary firepower.

The Brazilian government thought they were bandits; by the time they realized that these rip offs were political, it was too late. Urban guerrilla warfare had already started.

From 1968 onward, National Liberation Action began the boldest, most vicious attacks against the dictators. Banks were primary targets because they were so easy to hit, but the N.L.A. also hit armored cars, army trucks for pieces, bombed vital military-industrial complexes, assassinated by machine-gun fire enemies of the people like the c.i.a. spy charles chandler who had been sent from VietNam to infiltrate the Brazilian student movement, assassinated agents of the government like police chiefs, right-wing army officers, and large landowners besides ripping off their money.

According to Marighella there were two battles, urban guerrilla warfare and psychological warfare with the intent of putting a stranglehold on the triangle of cities, Sao Paulo, Rio de Janeiro, and Belo Horizonte since they were the centers of all activity in Brazil. The tactics were to first initiate urban guerrilla warfare, secondly, rural guerrilla warfare, and finally to enter into conventional warfare with a national liberation army.

The objective of N.L.A. is "to liberate Brazil and to force yanqui imperialism out."

Because of "regionalism," a feeling of loyalty toward one's region rather than nation, the National Liberation Action did not start as a unified national front. Also, in Brazil, there are 20 to 30 organizations claiming to be the "vanguard" and "revolutionary," but Marighella made it clear in Brazil that only action makes the vanguard. While he saw the need for a united national front, he said, "the most important problem for all of us is that everyone do his duty..." Even so, in October of 1969, Charles Elbrick, u.s. ambassador was kidnapped in exchange for the release of 15 political prisoners from different political perspectives. Carlos Marighella did not believe in too much rapping about unity. The actions of his group proved their desire for unity.

Once again the amerikkkan government has sent troops to push Caribbean people around. The island of Trinidad in the West Indies is run by a government that allows the United States and Great Britain to control the Trinidadian economy. Prime Minister Eric Williams is black, just like Ferre and Marin are Puerto Rican, but he does not support the move of the people towards self-determination or Black Power.

The Black, East Indian and mulatto people of Trinidad who are in the majority rioted against the government for many reasons. The situation there is the same or similar to that of the other islands in the Caribbean. One third of the people in Trinidad are unemployed and most of the people are illiterate. There are almost no health or sanitation services for the people. All the money that is made on the island that could be used to help the people, goes out from the island to great britain and amerikkka.

When the people rose up to demonstrate against their oppression, the government and 36 leaders of the rebellion were arrested and then denied permission to see their families and lawyers. One of the brothers who is ill in jail has not been allowed to see a doctor. A dusk to dawn curfew was imposed and every night the sounds of pigs shooting at the people were heard.

The Black Power movement in Trinidad is the same struggle that is being fought all over the world and here in amerikkka. In Washington, D.C. and New York last week, Trinidadian students demonstrated against the u.s. sending troops to their island, to help out the government of Prime Minister Williams. Just as in 1965 ships were sent from Puerto Rico to control the people of the Dominican Republic, this time the ships were sent to Trinidad. Puerto Rico is being used as a base of operations in the Caribbean to put down any protests against the amerikkkan government.

Point 3 of the YOUNG LORDS ORGANIZATION program and platform

On Monday, March 4, of the present year, at about 2:45 P.M., a high potency bomb was placed on the inside of Sears Roebuck & Co. in Brooklyn by the ARMED REVOLUTIONARY INDEPENDENCE MOVEMENT (MIRA) with the objective of systematically destroying the exploitative and oppressive agents of our nation, among them said company; at the same time we took the voice of armed struggle to our brothers and sisters in New York and solidified the revolutionary ties with our combatant brothers and sisters in Puerto Rico.

MIRA holds the New York City police responsible for those people injured in the explosion. The police were warned but took no precautions. OUR STRUGGLE IS AGAINST YANQUI IMPERIALISM, NOT AGAINST THOSE WHO SUFFER EXPLOITATION. Yet it is clear that nothing will detain our struggle, this is the struggle of the people and only the attainment of full liberty for our people will end the struggle. WE ARE AT WAR.

The armed struggle for liberation shall continue to grow through MIRA until the annihilation of those oppressive Yanqui forces that are opposed to all human progress as much in Puerto Rico as in the rest of the underdeveloped countries.

## Revolucion En Trinidad

La gente Negra y mulata, de las Indias del este, que son la mayoría, motinaron contra el gobierno por muchas razones. Las situaciones ahí son las mismas o similares a las que existen en las otras islas del Caribe. Una tercera parte de la gente en Trinidad esta desempleada y la mayoría es analfabeta. Casi no hay servicios medicos o sanitarios para la gente. Todo el dinero que se produce en la isla, que pudiera ser usado para ayudar el pueblo, en vez de ser enviado a Inglaterra y Amerikkka.

Otra vez el gobierno amerikkkan ha mandado tropas para abusar con las gentes del Caribe. La isla de Trinidad es manejada por un gobierno que deja que los estados unidos y Inglaterra controlen la economía. El primer ministro, Eric Williams es Negro, igual que Ferrey y Marin son Puertorriqueños, pero no respalda el esfuerzo del pueblo hacia auto-determinación o poder Negro.

Cuando el pueblo se levanto a demostrar en contra de su opresión, el gobierno puso leyes que le quitaba todos sus derechos personales y políticos, cuales son garantizados bajo la constitución Trinidadiana. Un estado de emergencia fue declarado por el gobierno y 36 líderes de la rebelión fueron arrestados, negándoseles el permiso de ver sus familias o abogados. Uno de los hermanos que estaban encarcelados y enfermo ha sido negado ver un doctor. Una limitación de tráfico callejero de atardecer a amanecer fue impuesta y los sonidos de la jara tiroteando la gente se oyen de noche.

Esta es la misma lucha que se está llevando a cabo por todo el mundo y a mí en Amerikkka. En Washington, D.C. y en Nueva York la semana pasada, estudiantes Trinidadianos demostraron en contra de las tropas mandadas a su isla por los Estados Unidos a ayudar el gobierno del primer ministro Williams, igual que en 1965, barcos de guerra fueron enviados de Puerto Rico a controlar la gente de la República Dominicana, esta vez los barcos fueron mandados a Trinidad. Puerto Rico se está usando como una base de operaciones en el Caribe para aplastar cualquier protesta en contra del gobierno amerikkkan.

## ASIANS WILL WIN

The month was April, the year, 1970. In Cambodia, villagers plowed their rice fields the way their ancestors have done for 5,000 years. Children played in their villages in the Kingdom of Cambodia. Suddenly gunfire, tanks, grenades, cannons, and fire surround the village, and the peaceful life of the Cambodian village (and hundreds like it all over the country) turned into a nightmare of death, pain, and suffering.

When the United States sent its armies (including the Vietnamese mercenaries) into Cambodia, it brought to that country the same genocide that it has been bringing down on the Vietnamese people for the past ten years. The excuse that the United States government gave for murdering the people of Cambodia was that the headquarters of the PRG (Provisional Revolutionary Government of South Vietnam) was in Cambodia and that if the war against "communist invaders" is to be won, their headquarters must be smashed.

Puerto Ricans, who have been the victims of Amerikkkan imperialism for the past 72 years, know better than that. The United States rulers (Rockefeller, Lindsay, I.B.M., A.T.&T., the bankers, etc.) have had their armies in Vietnam and all of Asia not because of any "communist invasion" but because they want to steal the rubber, oil, minerals, wood, and other wealth of the people of Asia. They have been doing this for 150 years in Latin America (where they have left the countries so empty and poor that Venezuela, for example, the world's biggest oil-exporting country, will be dry of oil in 14 years because of Amerikkkan exploitation).

U.S. imperialist expansion in Asia began with Japan, then spread to Korea, the Philippines, and is now trying to take over all of Southeast Asia. The countries there (Vietnam, Cambodia, Laos, Thailand) contain some of the richest deposits of wealth in the whole world. The United States capitalists because they need to keep robbing from the world in order to keep making more profits, understand that Southeast Asia is one of the last places left for it to take over and exploit (Africa is next).

But the people of Southeast Asia, especially the Vietnamese, are not standing by and allowing their land to be stolen and themselves to be killed. They are waging a people's war against the foreign Amerikkkan aggressor, to save their homeland. The United States cannot fool anybody by stating that they are fighting communist invaders; they are the invaders who are trying to take over other people's countries. If they are really fighting communism, why are they buying, selling, and trading with all of the so-called communist countries of Eastern Europe? It is

because the U.S. is a racist country that does not consider Third World, colored peoples as human beings. The United States dropped the atomic bomb on Japan, but not on Germany; it stole the land of the Indians in this country, and then wiped them out (genocide); it ripped off 60 million Africans from their homeland and subjected them to slavery in this country; it invaded Puerto Rico, and when we did not allow our land to be taken without a fight (Don Pedro Albizu Campos and the Nationalist Party's struggle), they killed us, arrested us, uprooted us from our island, and threw us into concentration camps in the ghettos of their cities and on their farms; they rounded up 60,000 Asian people during the second world war and put them in prison camps because the U.S. was fighting Japan, but did not do it to Germans and Italians though they were fighting against them too.

The men and women who are the presidents of the big companies and corporations, and who run city hall, the army, and Washington, are all vicious, racist murderers who will stop at nothing to make money, money, and more money, here and around the world.

So when the U.S. went into Cambodia, they were not surprised that they didn't find any "headquarters." They were never looking for any since they have stopped fighting people's armies. They tried that but were defeated when the Tet offensive of January, 1968, dealt the death blow to the Amerikkkan army in Vietnam. They are in Cambodia to wipe out the Cambodian people and take their wealth before a people's army can develop. In Vietnam, having already lost the war against the people's army, they have been trying to wipe out the Vietnamese people. When one hundred giant B-52 bombers, each carrying fifty bombs (each bomb weighing 2,000) drop these bombs all over the villages and cities and farms and fields, they are no longer fighting a war against an army, but committing genocide of the most vicious and inhuman kind.

We Puerto Ricans must understand that they will do the same in Puerto Rico when the people's army begins to kick out the U.S.'s military and political forces. We are beginning the first step of this by getting back Culebra. We must understand that at the appropriate time, we will be dealt with in the manner that the Vietnamese, the Indians, and the Cambodians were dealt with. Ponce, Cayey, Mayaguez, San Juan, Humacao, El Barrio, the South Bronx, South Boston, El Fanguito, Hartford, Conn.—all will be attacked by bombers, napalm, green berets, and biological and psychological warfare. We must prepare for this, for the process has already started.

But we must also remember that as Huey P. Newton, Minister of Defense of the Black Panther Party, has said, "The spirit of the people is greater than the man's technology." The YOUNG LORDS ORGANIZATION, in keeping with Point Number 5 of our Program (We want community control of our institutions and land) is waging a struggle to get Puerto Rican control of El Barrio, the South Bronx, and every other place that Borinquenos inhabit.

# MILITARY OCCUPATION OF CULEBRA

In 1898, the United States Army and Marines landed a force of 18,000 men in the southern town of Guanica and began the military occupation of our country that continues to this day. Since then, U.S. military forces have grown to include the U.S. Army, the Marines, the Air Force, the Navy, the Green Berets, the C.I.A., the F.B.I., Navy Intelligence, the Secret Service, Treasury Agents, the Coast Guard, the National Guard, and Puppet Police Forces. This total military and para-military force numbers over 100,000 men and women, and is spread over a giant air force base that has nuclear bomb carrying B-52 bombers, Navy bases that have nuclear missile carrying submarines, Army bases, Navy shelling positions, Green Beret training zone (Our sacred and beloved El Yunque national forest) and a counter guerrilla training base for spies to send to Latin America. This military occupation is so great today that 13% of all the land surface of Borinquen is occupied by military bases, posts, training areas, or firing zones.

## CULEBRA INVADED

This gigantic military concentration is not only used to continue and intensify the occupation and oppression of Puerto Ricans but also to invade and put down any of our Latin American brothers and sisters that decide that they no longer want to be dominated and oppressed by the United States.

But finally, our people have said "Basta Ya" and are demanding that the U.S. withdraw all its military troops and agents from our nation, especially Culebra.

Culebra is one of the four major islands that belong to the Puerto Rican Archipelago (group of islands). There are 14 other isillas that are a part of Puerto Rico. In 1941, President Roosevelt told the Navy that it could have Culebra for target practice, and the puppet colonial government of Munoz Marin began moving people out; homes were destroyed, jobs taken away, and people were generally forced to leave the land of their families and ancestors. Our people had no choice and were not organized enough then to rebel and fight because of the blindness that Munoz Marin had them under (pan, tierra, y libertad). The result was that half the island was literally cleared with bulldozers, and people who lived there had to move to the slums of San Juan and New York.

## PEOPLE BOMBED

Life for the brothers and sisters who remained has been a combination of constant harassment by the Navy—who rules the island with dictator powers, trying to get the rest of them to leave—and the actual fact of being bombed day in and day out. Men, women and children have been killed or maimed by bombs that have fallen off target or intentionally shot at the town to scare people. Finally, the people of Culebra could take no more when the Pitiyanqui, vendepatria, bootlicking—Uncle Tom—puppet-governor Ferre decided two months ago to sell all the island completely to the Navy. This would mean that everybody would have to leave with no homes to go to, no jobs, no transportation, nothing. Just get the fuck on out, and make room for some yanqui target practice, is what they were told.

Mayor Feliciano of Culebra organized our people and led a delegation to San Juan to protest and all they were told by Ferre's mouthpieces (he didn't have the guts to talk to them) was that nothing could be done. They went to the press and the rest of the people of Borinquen and explained the constant harassment, the keeping of fishermen from areas where Puerto Ricans have been fishing for 400 years, and the political and police persecution that they have received lately. Since the people have gotten organized and complained, all of the agents and police forces on the main island (Borinquen) have been investigating them, harassing them, and labeling them independentistas, communists, castroites, agents of the international communist conspiracy, and anti-American subversives.



But our people will not be intimidated into giving up our land for the days of being lied to and fooled are over. The 8,000 people of Culebra are organizing a massive campaign to get brothers and sisters from the main island to move to Culebra, and bring materials to build houses not only in the half that they have lived in, but in all of the 7,200 acres of the island. They want brothers and sisters to come and build their homes and reclaim the land that is ours and our children's.

Point #5 of the YLO Program states: "We want community control of our institutions and land." This applies to Puerto Rican communities in the United States and to all the parts of our homeland, including Culebra. Boricuas both here and in Puerto Rico must begin to repossess the land and wealth that has been taken from us through 72 years of yanqui military occupation. The YOUNG LORDS ORGANIZATION completely supports our brothers and sisters in Culebra, and we call upon Puerto Ricans everywhere to do everything possible to support our people's efforts to take back Culebra. People to populate the island, building materials, money for transportation, and anything else you can think of to aid in the struggle are needed. This must be the beginning of the complete repossession not only of Culebra, but also of the islands of Vieques and Mona, and the immediate withdrawal of all U.S. military forces and bases from Borinquen proper.

## EEUU OCUPA A CULEBRA

En el 1898 el ejercito de los Estados Unidos aterrizó una fuerza de 18,000 hombres en el pueblo de Guanica y empezó la ocupación militar de nuestro país que continúa hasta hoy. Desde esa fecha las fuerzas militares han crecido a incluir el ejercito, los marinos, la fuerza aérea, la marina, los "green berets," la C.I.A., el F.B.I., la inteligencia de la marina, el servicio secreto, agentes tesoreros, la guardia de costas, la guardia nacional y la policía colonial alcahuete. Esta fuerza total militar y para-militar constituye más de 100,000 hombres y mujeres extendidos sobre una gigantesca base aérea que tiene aviones B-52 cargadores de bombas nucleares; bases marinas, zonas de entrenamiento de "green berets" (en nuestro sagrado y querido Yunque); y una base de entrenamiento anti-guerrilla para espías designados para Latino América. Esta gigantesca concentración militar es usada no sólo para continuar e intensificar la ocupación y opresión de Puertorriqueños pero también para invadir y aplastar cualquiera de nuestros hermanos y hermanas Latinoamericanos que decidan ya no ser dominados y oprimidos por los Estados Unidos.

Pero, por fin, nuestra gente ha dicho "BASTA YA" y están demandando que los Estados Unidos retiren todas sus tropas militares y agentes de nuestra nación, en particular de Culebra.

## CORTEJAS

It is a well known fact that in our Puerto Rican culture married men are encouraged to have a woman on the side, or what we call "una corteja." It is a fact of our society that we try to hide, yet it is there and is clearly oppressive to our women. The wife is there to be a homemaker, to have children and to maintain the family name and honor. Therefore she must be "pure" to begin with—virgin—and remain "pure" for the rest of her life, meaning no sexual pleasure. The wife must have children in order to enhance the man's concept of virility and his position within the Puerto Rican society. La corteja becomes his sexual instrument. The man may set her up in another household, paying her rent, buying her food, and paying her bills. The man may have children with this woman, but they are looked upon as by-products of a sexual relationship. Both women must be loyal to the man. Both women are exploited, neither being allowed to develop as total human beings and being forced into dependency on a man for status. Also both sets of children grow up very confused and insecure and develop negative attitudes about the role and function of women as well as a messed up concept of what manhood is.

We know that under capitalism, manhood is defined according to the amount of money a male has. Puerto Ricans, since they are exploited by capitalists, have no money, and as a result no status or prestige, and as a result no status or prestige. As Eldridge Cleaver puts it, our men are "debailed." Since they can't prove manhood economically, they try to do it sexually at the expense of their women.

We say that for our men to have a corteja is oppressive to women. The 10th point of the YOUNG LORDS ORGANIZATION Platform states: "WE WANT EQUALITY FOR WOMEN. Machismo must be revolutionary and not oppressive." The exploitation of Puerto Rican women on the part of Puerto Rican men must stop; Puerto Rican men must realize that machismo is an extension of capitalism and must be gotten rid of. Puerto Rican women must realize that the main oppressor is u.s. capitalism. As Puerto Rican people, we must not allow this racist decadent system to rule our lives because it destroys us. Therefore, we must destroy it first. We have to control our own destinies and determine our lives in order to be free to create a new and equitable system for women and men. Our people must pick up the gun and say to the pig, Basta ya!

## CULEBRA...

Culebra es una de las islas mayores del archipiélago (grupo de islas) Puertorriqueño. Hay 14 otras isillas que son partes de Puerto Rico. En el 1941, el presidente Roosevelt le dijo a su marina que podía usar a Culebra para practicar tiros a blanco, y el gobierno colonial alcahuete de Muñoz Marín empezo a mudar la gente; casas fueron destruidas, trabajos quitados, y la gente generalmente forzada a dejar la tierra de sus familias y antepasados. Nuestra gente no tuvo alternativa ninguna y no estaba suficientemente organizada en ese entonces para rebelarse y pelear a causa del sueño en que los tenía Muñoz Marín (pan, tierra, y libertad). El resultado fue que la mitad de la isla fue destruida con "bulldozers" y la gente que allí vivían tuvieron que mudarse a los arrabales de San Juan y Nueva York.

La vida de los hermanos y hermanas que han quedado ha sido una combinación de constante jodiendas por parte de la marina —que domina la isla con poderes de dictador, tratando de sacar el resto de gente— y el hecho actual de ser bombardados día tras día. Hombres, niños, y mujeres han sido matados o heridos por bombas que han caído fuera de su sitio o han sido intencionalmente tiradas al pueblo para meterle miedo a la gente. Por fin, la gente de Culebra no pudieron aguantar más cuando el pitiryanqui, vendepatria, lambe-ojos, alcahuete gobernador colonial ferre decidió hace dos meses venderle la isla completa a la marina norteamericana. Esto quiere decir que todos tendrán que irse sin hogares, trabajo o transportación, nada. Vayanse pal carajo, y hagan espacio para la práctica a tiros

blancos de los yanquis, fue lo que le dijeron.

El Alcalde Feliciano, de Culebra, organizó al pueblo, y fue con una delegación a San Juan a protestar. Lo que le dijo el bichipluma de ferre (quien no tuvo los cojones de hablarte) fue que no se podía hacer nada. Fueron entonces a la prensa y al pueblo de Borinquen para explicarle las molestias constantes, el no dejar pescar en sitios donde Puertorriqueños han pescado por cuatrocientos años, y la persecución política y policiaca que han recibido últimamente. Desde que la gente se ha organizado y quejado, todos los agentes y policías de Borinquen le han investigado y jodido y llamado independentistas, comunistas, castroistas, agentes de la conspiración internacional comunista y subversivos anti-americanos.

Pero nuestra gente no serán intimidados a dejar ir nuestra isla porque los días de ser engañados se han acabado. Las 8,000 personas que viven en Culebra están organizando una campaña masiva para lograr que hermanos y hermanas de la isla mayor se muden a Culebra y traigan materiales para construir casas no solo en la mitad de la isla donde han vivido, pero en todas las 7,000 cuerdas de la isla. Quieren que compañeros y compañeras vengan, construyan casas y reclamen la tierra que es nuestra y de nuestros niños.

El punto 5 del programa de la OYL dice "Queremos control comunal de todas nuestras instituciones y tierra." Esto se aplica a comunidades Puertorriqueñas tanto aquí como en nuestra patria, inclusive Culebra. Boricuas aquí y en Puerto Rico tienen que empezar a reposar la tierra y riqueza que nos han quitado bajo 72 años de ocupación militar yanqui. La ORGANIZACIÓN DE LOS YOUNG LORDS apoya completamente a nuestros hermanos y hermanas en Culebra y les pedimos a Puertorriqueños en todas partes que hagan todo lo posible para soportar los esfuerzos de nuestra gente a recobrar Culebra. Se necesitan gente para poblar la isla, materiales para construir, dinero para transportación y cualquier otra cosa que ustedes piensen que se necesita para la lucha. Esto tiene que ser el principio de la completa reposición no solo de Culebra, pero de las islas de Vieques y Mona, y del retiro inmediato de todas las fuerzas militares y bases norteamericanas de Borinquen propia.

## BRAZIL...

Carlos Marighella, the man who built the organization that turned the course of Brazilian history was gunned down in São Paulo by army and police bullets on November 4, 1969, a month after the kidnapping. It was said that he took care of everyone else's personal safety much better than he took care of his own. He was 58

years of age, a revolutionary till death. When asked by a French journalist whether he would carry out his revolutionary work to the end, he answered, "The revolution does not depend on individuals, but is a matter of the people and their vanguard. My role was to give the initial spark. Our organization, for the most part, is made up of young people under 25 years old. It is up to the best of them to provide the leadership. One of them will take up my banner, or if you prefer, my gun."

To his Brazilian compañeros, Carlos Marighella left a burning example of what must be done in the face of murderous oppression.

To his Third World compañeros, he left his thoughts on war, the Mini-Manual of the Urban Guerrilla, and other writings and a taste for the blood of the yanqui monster in their respective countries.

As for us here in norteamerikkka, particularly Puerto Ricans, educate quietly and gun the motherfucker down.

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## RULES OF DISCIPLINE OF THE YOUNG LORDS ORGANIZATION

Every member of the YOUNG LORDS ORGANIZATION must follow these rules. CENTRAL COMMITTEE members, CENTRAL and BRANCH STAFFS, including all captains, will enforce these rules.

Every member of the party must memorize these rules, and apply them daily. Any member found violating these rules is subject to suspension by the ORGANIZATION.

### THE RULES ARE:

1. You are a YOUNG LORD 25 hours a day.
2. Any ORGANIZATION member busted on a jive tip which that member brought down on himself or others, can swim alone.
3. Any member found shooting drugs will be expelled.
4. No member may have any illegal drug in his or her possession or in their system while on duty. No one may get drunk on duty.
5. No member will violate rules relating to office work or general meetings of the ORGANIZATION ANYWHERE.
6. No one will point or fire a weapon of any kind unnecessarily or accidentally at anyone.
7. No member can join any army force other than the People's Army of Liberation.
8. No ORGANIZATION member will commit crimes against the people.
9. When arrested, YOUNG LORDS will give only name, address, and will sign nothing. Legal first aid must be understood by all members.
10. No member may speak in public unless authorized by the Central Committee or Central Staff.
11. The 13 Point Program must be memorized and the Platform must be understood by each member.

12. ORGANIZATION communications must be national and local.

13. No member may speak about another member unless he or she is present.

14. All ORGANIZATION business is to be kept within the ORGANIZATION.

15. All contradictions between members must be resolved at once.

16. Once a week all Chapters and Branches will conduct a criticism and self-criticism session.

17. All members will relate to Chain of Command. Officers will discipline officers, cadre, and so on. The O.D. is the final authority in the office.

18. Each person will submit a daily report of work to the O.D..

19. Each YOUNG LORD must learn to operate and service weapons correctly.

20. All Leadership personnel who expel a member, must submit this information, with photo, to the Editor of the newspaper, so that it will be published in the paper, and known by all Chapters and Branches.

21. Political Education classes are mandatory for general membership.

22. All members must read at least one political book a month, and at least two hours a day on contemporary matters.

23. Only assigned ORGANIZATION personnel should be in office each day. All others are to sell papers and do political work out in the community, including captains, section leaders, etc..

24. All Chapters must submit weekly report in writing to National Headquarters.

25. All Branches must implement First Aid/Medical Cadres.

26. All Chapters and Branches must submit a weekly financial report to the Ministry of Finance.

27. No Chapter or Branch shall accept grants, poverty funds, money, or any aid from any government agency.

28. All Traitors, Provocateurs, and Agents will be subject to Revolutionary Justice.

29. At all times we keep a united front before all forms of the man. This is true not only among LORDS, but all Revolutionary Companeros.

30. All Chapters must adhere to the policy and ideology put forth by the Central Committee of the YLO. Likewise, all members will know all information published by the ORGANIZATION.






## 13. WE WANT A SOCIALIST SOCIETY
