INTRODUCTION TO SECOND EDITION

This booklist arose out of many requests for advice on reading matter on the subject of women's liberation. That it is needed is shown by the rapidity with which the first edition sold out. The list here has, besides some books so new that at the time of writing they are still on the "Books to Come" list, some very old books of rather limited interest; these latter are included both for the benefit of those doing research and to give some idea of the books written in bygone days. I have restricted the titles mainly to those mentioned in more modern works. American and other "foreign" books are restricted, too, otherwise the list would be far too long, and those included are those generally available in this country. No doubt there are many mistakes and omissions and I welcome corrections. I would also be grateful for details of books not mentioned in this list. As I have by no means read all the books, some are bound to be in the wrong category, or perhaps they should not be in the list at all.

The new edition is arranged under categories and contains about 100 more titles than the first. The list of Women's Liberation Groups has been enlarged, showing how much the movement is growing, even in a matter of weeks. A list of American groups is also included this time.

The "Recommended Books" are, of course, chosen from those I have read, so that I have found myself revising the list several times as my reading turns up something better! I have tried to choose books that are, above all, readable; no matter how worthy a book may be, if one cannot read it because of boredom, then it is useless. Unfortunately, to my mind the definitive book on the working women today has not yet been written, although several rather dull books covering some aspects of the question do exist. Another difficulty is that I read some of the books some time ago, so perhaps I am counting on the fact that I remember them at all to prove that they are interesting.

Finally, I would like to thank the staff of the Southall Central Library for putting up with me this past year, and for generally being so helpful.

SOME RECOMMENDED BOOKS

For a good overall look at our present situation, PATRIARCHAL ATTITUDES by Eva Figes is a fascinating study of the way in which society has developed the attitudes which most people take for God-given granted. Ways in which the system is beginning to break down are examined in THE CHANGING ROLES OF MEN AND WOMEN by Dahlstrom, which studies investigations in various parts of Europe.

Particularly on the position of American women today, Betty Friedan's FEMININE MYSTIQUE is required reading if only because it is regarded as having set off the present American movement; it is especially interesting on the mass media. More up-to-date, but concentrating on the field of employment, is BORN FEMALE by Caroline Bird.

On the three campaigns at present being undertaken by the Women's National Coordinating Committee, I suggest: THE NAMELESS by Paul Ferris, WORKING MOTHERS AND THEIR CHILDREN by Simon Yudkin and Anthea Holmes and LOCKED-UP DAUGHTERS by Felicia Lamb and Helen Pickthorn.

There are many histories covering different aspects of the women's movement and its background. I particularly enjoyed Alice Clerk's WORKING LIFE OF ENGLISH WOMEN IN THE 17th CENTURY. The best on the suffrage movement, out of a generally dull lot, is probably WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE AND PARTY POLITICS by Constance Rover. A book which gives not only a historical background, but is also an introduction to Victorian fiction, is VICTORIAN WORKING WOMEN by Wanda Neff. Several books which tell the history of the fight for equality in the various fields through the story of the women involved exist, and about the best is GO SPIN, YOU JADE! by D. Hobman; THE BLOOMER GIRLS by C. N. Gattey does the same thing for the American movement. Books which draw on original contemporary material are: W. L. O'Neiil's THE WOMAN MOVEMENT, THE PUNCH BOOK OF WOMEN'S RIGHTS by Constance Rover and WOMEN IN REVOLT by Jackdaw Publications.

All these books are fairly easily obtained from your library, but I would also recommend the various publications put out by the various groups involved in Women's Liberation.

NOTES

The books are listed under the author's name. Several books are published by more than one publisher at different times; in this case I have given the latest publisher (to the best of my knowledge) or the cheapest edition. The date given is, as far as possible, of the latest and most easily obtainable edition; in any case, all the information given is intended to help you order it from either library or bookseller. Those books with the prices marked are generally still in print, but you may be able to find some of the other books, too.

The categories are overlapping, but I have generally put books into one section only. The dividing line between "history" and today" I have made rather arbitrarily at the end of World War Two in most cases, although perhaps it should have been a much later date—say, the year the Pill came into general use!
