My impression is that we are still trying to make the NDP our point of differentiation from Waffle. Not stay in and fight this time but from a point of view of orientation now that the Sask Waffle has set off on an independent course and Ontario is having a big discussion in a conference this weekend. There is nother in this for us it seems to me -- we should be discussing the problems of building a revolutionary organization-world outlook, Staliniam, social democracy, the state. It is hard to believe that any new form stion that came out of the wefile would be able to take a sectarian position on the NDP. even though it first has to define itself in relation to it. weakningham we are tring to make out that Sask is
