I have just a few quick notes to keep in touch.

If you have been wondering why you have not recieved a copy of Socialist Norker in three weeks so have we. None have arrived from England in three weeks. I have written to Socialist Worker and asked why. You will again recieve them as soon as we do.

There is a similar stroy with Womens Voice. We have only been recieving a bundle of 10 despite the fact that we have requested 40 per month.

I have placed large orders for books with publishers. As soon as the majority of them come in I will put out a list of books that Sun has available to the branches. I would think this to be sometime in October.

A whole flock of new pamphlets are in the works. With luck all of them will be printed by Christmas. On the press right now is a bibliography of Women's books by Barbara W. In the next three weeks we hope to hvae ready a reprint of the <u>Communism and the Family</u> pamphlet. Still in the writing stages are one on Working Women today and Russia: How th e Revolution was Won.

If your branch does not have an adequate supply of the basic education pamphlet on hand then order some now. It will save delays later.

There are still several branches that are far behind on paying for their literature. I urge each of them to make every effort to make regular payments. Remember, we have lost our rights to Pluto. This puts the real burden for maintaining Sun on the branches.
