



The national campaign committee received 358 inquiries between

Jan. 1 and Mar. 30, 1976. The inquiries came from people in 42

states plus the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the Canal Zone,

Canada, and army bases in Europe.

Two_hundred of the inquiries were letters. Seventy-nine were Bill of Rights coupons. The remainder were assorted materials and Militant and Young Socialist coupons.
