CIO Gives Up **Steel Drive**

But it is definitely known that for the past few weeks organizing efforts have been concentrated on the organization of workers in small plants which CONSUME steel such as foundries. It is also reported that the CIO is organizing workers such as retail clerks into the CRAFT unions of the A.F. of L.

In 29 states there are no provisions for putting a new party on the ballot at all.

In Illinois a workers party must get 25,000 signatures, at least 200 from each of 50 counties.
