The Failure of the Red Cross.

Confronted with the terrific destitution in Europe as a result of wars and blockades, the working class of America has been asked to give generously for the relief of suffering in those countries.

Millions of dollars have been raised in America for the relief of Europe. How much of this money has actually been of service to the working class?

Two MILLION dollars' worth of medical supplies desperately needed in Russia were burned by the American Red Cross in the Crimea to prevent it falling into the hands of the Workers' Government.

Supplies to the value of 10 MILLION dollars were allowed to rot at Archangel because the Red Cross would not permit the starving and dying Russians to use them.

Henry P. Davison, partner of J.P. Morgan, is Chairman of the Red Cross. Under his direction millions of dollars' worth of supplies generously contributed in good faith by the American People to relieve distress in all countries are wasted and burned, rather than have them used by people who will not be dictated to by the Morgan interests.

This does not occur in Russia alone. In Hungary, Austria, Italy, and other countries the liberal workers are entirely neglected and are left to starve and die because of their political beliefs. Such is the case in Ireland, where the Red Cross has made no effort to help the outraged victims of the British reign

of terror.

Disgust and horror, nationally expressed, has brought no change in their policies and tactics. The *Chicago Herald-Examiner* of January 11 [1921], editorially comments upon the Red Cross in Italy as follows:

Anybody knows that the Red Cross has become to a high degree institutionalized. It is now a huge and tremendously complex organization. As such it seems to have adopted a political policy, to be affected by questions of international propriety, to have stiffened in the armor of political considerations.

It was founded to relieve suffering wherever suffering exists. It seems to have determined now upon the plan of relieving suffering wherever politicians agree that suffering ought to be relieved, but not for instance in Russia, which is politically improper, and therefore has no real right to suffer at all.

Under the leadership of Herbert Hoover a joint committee of relief organizations has been formed, which is openly using the funds collected for anti-labor propaganda. In a letter now being circulated this committee says:

Malnutrition is very likely to produce not only a diseased body but a diseased mind, a **fertile source for radical propaganda and discontent.**

This explains why the profiteers are rushing to the relief of Europe and also why Soviet Russia does not appear on the list of nations they are collecting funds to help: "A word to the wise is sufficient!"
