Declaration.

By Carr [Katterfeld] for the CEC of the CP of A (Majority) and Moor [Ballam] for the Minority Group.

- 1. The CEC (Majority) will reinstate in the CP of A every member of the minority (including members expelled or disconnected because of the factional controversy incidental to the development of the Legal Party) who
- (a) conforms to the decision of the CEC and the EC of the CI to join the Legal Party [Workers Party of America], and
- (b) pays the current month's dues through the regular party channels.
- 2. Members of the Minority reinstated within 60 days will not be discriminated against in the exercise of the membership rights on account of their past activities.
- 3. The Party Convention will be held on such a date that all such members may participate in the election of electors within the sections.

- 4. The Minority Group will immediately cease all attacks upon the Majority and the Legal Party [WPA]. It will not issue any more circulars or publications without the consent of the CEC (Majority).
- 5. The Minority will at once turn over all its records, addresses, connections, and properties to the CEC (Majority) and will then dissolve.
- 6. Moore [Ballam] and Carr [Katterfeld] pledge themselves to do all in their power to cooperate with the comrade appointed by the EC of the CI to help carry out its decisions.†
