Making A Difference Plainer

The recent death of Henry George, Jr., has called attention to an analysis of the trade union movement in one of his books, "The Menace of Privilege," that will serve the purpose once more of helping to show the difference between the American Federation of Labor and the I. W. W. The analysis as quoted by the New York Sun of Nov. 15, is as follows:

"Now the growth in numerical strength," he wrote, "and the centralising movement among the trade unions calls forth a power in no way provided for in our civil polity. It is not a power accountable to the masses of the people unless it in some way infracts the general laws. Short of that it is responsible only to those who brought it into existence, who compose it, and who dieset it. Its policy is not the fundamental one of killing privilege and so of ending the necessity of militant unionism among laborers. It assumes that privilege must not only continue to exist, but grow, and that the only recourse for workingmen is to extend their organization to meet it.
"The chief aim of labor unionism is to raise wages and re-

graw, and that the only recourse for workingmen is to extend their organization to the control of the control o

the National Civic Federation and the Wilson Administration. In both we see unmistakable evidence of the truth of George's analysis.

IT WOULD EMANCIPATE LABOR AND INTERNATE HUMANITY BY ABOLISHING CAPITALISM. And which accordingly, is more damned and persecuted than any other organization in the field of abor. Its refusal to aid privilege and thwart progress has made it anethema, while the A. F. of L is received with open arms as "a different kind of union."
