RESOLUTION OF THE NATIONAL COUNCIL

The National Council adopted the following resolution in its session held at New Delhi from June 7 to 17, 1964:

Having heard and discussed the report of the Drafting Commission 'On the Unity of the Party and the International Communist Movement—Against Dogmatist Disruption, Adventurism and Opportunism', the National Council approves the report, with such improvements as have been accepted by the Drafting Commission on the basis of the discussion in the National Council and authorises the Drafting Commission to place the finalised draft, as the draft of the National Council, for discussion before the ensuing Party conferences at all levels and for discussion and approval at the next Congress of the CPI.

The report submitted to the National Council has been improved and finalised in accordance with the directives of the foregoing resolution. The finalised text is being herewith placed before Party conferences at all levels and the ensuing Seventh Congress of the Party.
